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and Process

- Summer 2017 roundtables with college faculty of University Council committees and the University Council Chair
- The Dean provided four major updates to Faculty Council in 2017-18
- The Committee of Department Heads discussed the college plan at several of their monthly meetings, and received presentations.
- College Planning Advisory Committee (CPAC), met six times over Term 2 and last week
- Specific meetings were held with the Undergraduate Student Office, including University Transition and Trish Monture Centre staff, all college directors, the ASSU Council, the college's Curriculum Renewal Advisory Committee, and the Department of Indigenous Studies
- Two daylong Dean's Executive Committee retreats about college planning; each member of Dean's Executive met with IPA to discuss metrics
- WebEx conferences with regional college leadership



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Steps to Plan Submission

- Sept 10: final meeting of CPAC 1.0
- Sept 24: each member of the Dean's Executive Committee finalize summaries of their portfolios, with accompanying targets – college community will be notified when they are posted on planning website
- Oct 1: Dean meets with Department Heads' Roundtable
- Oct 4: Faculty Council meeting (college plan is an agenda item)
- Oct 30: deadline for A&S to hand in final plan to provost's office
